Commonwealth Credit Union Awards \$4,000 in Scholarships

Frankfort, KY (June 10, 2022)- The key to Kentucky's future is equipping our next generation with the tools to become tomorrow's leaders. To help students acquire these tools and achieve their educational dreams, Commonwealth Credit Union has awarded four graduating high school seniors with a \$1,000 scholarship.

Each year, Commonwealth Credit Union invites graduating high school seniors who are current members to apply for their High School Scholarship Program. Students apply through a video submission where they answer questions about how they are bettering lives in their communities, how their future education will enable them to better lives, and how Commonwealth Credit Union can better the lives of college students. An external panel of Louisville Metro Area and Central Kentucky professionals reviews and scores each submission. This year's winners are -

Jacob Hogan: Jacob is a graduate of Franklin County High School and plans to attend the University of Kentucky.

Addison Riley: Addison is a Mercer County High School graduate and plans to attend Campbellsville University.

Haven Six: Haven is a Mercer County High School graduate and plans to attend Eastern Kentucky University.

Zachary Tackett: Zachary is a graduate of Lexington Christian Academy and plans to attend the University of Kentucky.
